During the month of February, our Florida college students will once again be assaulted by anti-choice fanatics doing what they always do, trying to impose their will and rules on other people. In the past, in an effort to brainwash students to their anti-choice position, the Center for Bio-Ethical Reform has descended on college campuses around the country, erected 4' by 8' sheets of plywood papered with photos of lynched black men, Hitler, and a fetus next to a dime, comparing acts of heinous atrocity with a woman's right to choose. A few young men are willing to take their pamphlets, but we have found that, for the most part, young women ignore them. Young women feel secure in their right to choose, and we commend them for it, but caution that this is a false sense of security. Sadly, the right to a safe and legal abortion has, since the Roe v Wade decision, been under attack by extremists such as these. Indeed, since the Roe v. Wade decision in 1973, hundreds of restrictions have been passed. In fact, Florida has unconstitutional and unenforceable restrictions, which will vastly reduce access for Florida's women if Roe v. Wade is overturned, a likely event if our next president is anti-choice.

Florida National Organization for Women stands unconditionally for a woman's right to choose and against any interference with this right.
